

Teachers: Please go over these rules and tips with your students before your visit.

1. Always follow the instructions the Clark Planetarium staff give you. We want you to be safe and have a good time, and the best way to do that is to follow instructions.
2. Remember to use inside voices in the exhibit halls.
3. Take turns with exhibits. Only play with exhibits that don't have a barrier around them. If you aren't sure if you can touch an exhibit, ask a teacher or chaperone for help.
4. There may be other groups in the building, please be respectful of each other and the other groups.
5. Please do not run, jump, or play on the stairs in the exhibits and in theaters.
6. Please do not use the elevator during your visit. However, guests with special needs are welcome to use the elevator
7. If you are having lunch during the IMAX film, please follow these guidelines:
  - Make sure you have your food with you before you are seated
  - Please make sure you clean up your area when the film ends.
8. Follow the chaperone's instructions about when to be at your theater. While being seated, please listen to the Planetarium employees when they tell you where to sit.
9. Your teacher may have instructed you not to visit the Store or Concessions stand during your visit. Only enter these places if an adult is with you and your teacher has said it is alright.
10. Most importantly, we want you to learn something new and have fun!
